Introduction:

Event Format:

He/ She have to study the system completely and identify the loopholes in it. The Participants have to come up with a method or technique which uses technology as an aid to reduce or eliminate these loopholes, thus making the system more efficient.

Problem Statement:

The idea should be submitted in form of a write-up which should include the following:

- Description of the current scenario or prevailing system in the chosen sector or field.
- Reasons for choosing the sector or field.
- Proposed changes in the current system.
- Description of how present technological advancements and digitalization could help your proposed changes.



- Develop a new system to tackle corruption in that sector (if possible)
- Impact of proposed system on society and economy.
- Justification of the proposed system.

Note:

1. Participants should mail their write-up in pdf format to submissions@wissenaire.org with Subject of the mail as *Abhyudaya*.
2. The last date of submission of solution is **23rd January**.

- Maximum number of participants in the team should not exceed three.
- No participant can take part in more than one team.
- Participants from different colleges can form teams.
- No Restriction on number of teams from one college.
